Jansz Premium Non Vintage Cuvee

Tasting Note: From the Pipers River area in North East Tasmania this premium Cuvee is based on several vintages, extended aging with aromas of nougat and roasted nuts. The fine bead and persistent mousse is complemented by delicate strawberry and citrus fruit flavours, with a creamy, lingering finish.

White Wines

Chardonnay

Cockfighter's Ghost McLaren Vale Chardonnay 2011 (McLaren Vale, SA)

Tasting Note: Well made, the small portion of barrel-ferment lying behind the considerable intensity and length of the nectarine, citrus and melon palate. Surprise packet.

Phaedrus Chardonnay 2013 (Mornington Peninsula, Vic)

Tasting Note: Elegant and expressive; quite intense stone fruit flavours complexed by sophisticated fermentation techniques and astute oak use.

Pinot Gris

Phaedrus Pinot Gris 2014 (Mornington Peninsula, Vic)

Tasting Note: Gentle spice, pear and apple fruit; wanders along on the way to the finish.

Riesling

Glaetzer-Dixon Uberblanc Riesling 2013 (Tas)

Tasting Note: Delicate lime zest and floral aromas fill the glass. Further citrus flavours develop on the fresh mineral structure, enhanced by the juicy acid finish.

Georgiana Sauvignon Blanc 2013 (Margaret River, WA)

Tasting Note: This is a vibrant, fresh and aromatic sauvignon blanc, which exhibits zesty citrus and tropical aromas. The palate is juicy and clean, balancing the full flavours and generous length to make it a very approachable and versatile white wine.

Tasting Note: Green apple, asparagus, Gooseberry flavoured, typical what Marlborough can offer.

Bethany Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2012 (Barossa Valley, SA)

Tasting Note: No reduction whatsoever; the sauvignon blanc from a neighbour with a cool site; a real surprise packet, offering flavour without phenolics.

Red Wines

Durif

All Saints Estate Durif 2012 (Rutherglen, Vic)

Tasting Note: An essay into durif with poise; loaded with succulent dark fruits and elements of spice, the fruit envelopes the palate, but does not weigh it down.

Merlot

Smoking Jim Chopping Block Merlot 2010

45

Tasting Note: Tight firmly yet generous palate weight. Assertive velvety tannins relax then allow the generous red fruits slip out and take the tongue seductively. The mouth is filled from top to bottom, front to back in an assertive but not aggressively display of three point balance between the spice fruit and gentle oak treatment. The tannins and firm acid cleanse and allow the wine to linger for an intensely enjoyable long time.

Leconfield Coonawarra Merlot 2011
(Coonawarra McLaren Vale, SA) 42
Tasting Note: Quite firm, clear-cut varietal character, with plum and redcurrant fruit running through a long palate and extended finish; good management of extract.

Pinot Noir

Glaetzer-Dixon Avance Pinot Noir 2012 (Tas) 45
Tasting Note: Bright cherry and raspberry aromas continue to a full flavoured palate of fresh mixed red berries. Silky tannins and integrated acid balances and lengthens the delicious finish.

Phaedrus Pinot Noir 2011 (Mornington, Vic) 11 45
Tasting Note: A generous wine; spiced plum fruit on the upper edge of ripeness; solid finish.

Phaedrus Reserve Pinot Noir 2006 (Mornington, Vic)
(only 800 bottles made) 138
Tasting Note: Fragrant, tangy/smoky aromas, excite the palate with considerable velocity thanks to savoury forestry characters coming through strongly. This wine has developed a very well.

Seville Estate Reserve Pinot Noir 2007 (Yarra Valley, Vic) 138
Tasting Note: Very complex array of dark cherry/plum fruit, spice, French oak and tannins.

Red Blends

Bethany Shiraz Cabernet 2010 (Barossa Valley, SA) 38
Tasting Note: A somewhat developed bouquet, the palate soft and fleshy, and ready to go; hints of cassis frame the supple blackberry fruit.

Hayward Shiraz-Viognier 2006 (Locksley, Vic) 10 38
Tasting Note: Vibrant deep ruby red, nose displays floral characters along with intense spices, cinnamon, clove and roasted peppercorns. Palate is savoury with liquorice, aniseed and red berries.

Tasting Note: Silky, smooth and sophisticated, the seamless blend of two old friends. Cabernet and Shiraz. Ripe purple berries and a lift of herbal leaf, savoury and elegant with fine tannins and a lingering richness.

Coriole Shiraz 2011 (McLaren Valley, SA)

Tasting Note: Excellent colour; a luscious and rich palate, yet not jammy or alcoholic, the plush black fruits offset by balanced tannins and integrated oak.

Seville Estate Old Wine Reserve Shiraz 2005 (Yarra Valley)

Tasting Note: Quite cool and spicy aromas, herbs and medium bodied red fruits on the palate. Quite fine wine.

Soul Growers Shiraz 2010

Tasting Note: Vintage blend 100% Shiraz. Dark crimson in colour. The nose is lifted, spicy fresh fruit which carries on to the palate with deep rich berry fruit characters. Palate is complemented by oak complexity with depth of flavour and an elegant mouth feel.
